After 49 years, the illustrious unit, first known as the Western Field Office (WFO), then the 1155th Technical Operations Squadron, and finally, the Technical Operations Division is coming to a close. The commemorative inactivation ceremony will take place on the morning of 9 April 1999, followed by an open house, and concluded with a banquet dinner-dance. The theme for the scheduled events will be "A Heritage Remembered" and will focus on the history of the unit and those who served proudly. The Technical Operations Division will officially be inactivated 30 September 1999 with most of the unit members to leave McClellan AFB by 13 August 1999. The world-class McClellan Central Laboratory (MCL) component of TOD will be outsourced and the depot maintenance, supply, and technical services will be moved to San Antonio, Texas

A FIRST CLASS REUNION

The reunion will be held at the Holiday Inn Northeast. This hotel is currently going through major renovations which are scheduled to be completed this November.

HOSPITALITY SUITE

The suite will be our place to relax, enjoy a cool drink or coffee and renew old friendships.

This suite will serve as the location for the reunion registration desk. It will also serve as a focal point for the reunion when nothing else is scheduled.

The hospitality suite will open on Thursday at 8 a.m. and close on Sunday at 11 a.m.

The suite will have a room that can be reserved for minireunions, which must be coordinated at the reunion registration desk. Signup will be available upon arrival.

GOLF TOURNAMENT

Lawrence Links (McClellan AFB Golf Course) will be utilized for the tournament. Lawrence Links is a par 72 nine-hole course with separate tees for the front and back fairways. A maximum of 72 players (male and female) can be accomodated with a shotgun start.

Lawrence Links requires soft spikes. Presently, green fees are \$6 for E1-E4, \$11 for E5 and above, and \$11 for DOD civilians. Reciprocal fees are 75% of regular fees (bring your base membership card). Golf carts are available for \$16, pull carts for \$2 and rental clubs for \$5 per set.

The tournament will be stroke play. To assist us in establishing handicap flights, please advise us of your present handicap. Those without a handicap will compete within a Calloway flight. Be at the links NLT 12:00 noon for a shotgun start at 12:30 p.m.
