He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Theresa Elizabeth (Lemieux); two children, a daughter Mary Anne Lynne Olson, a son, Thomas William, Jr., two loving grandchildren, Amber Lea Olson and Nicholaus Sean Olson, and several cousins in New York. Colonel Ciambrone graduated from High School in Niagara Falls, N.Y., received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemical Engineering from the University of Rochester, and his Masters Degree from the University of Southern California.

He entered the United States Air Force in 1957 and retired in 1987. He then worked at Scientific Application International Corporation until his retirement. He was a member of Ascension Catholic Church. A lifetime member of Sigma Chi Fraternity, the Air Force Association, the Patrick Officers Club, the American Legion, and an honorary member of the Master Sergeant Association. He was an avid train collector, enjoyed his sports and truly enjoyed his many friends from all walks of life.
