Joe has been selected 'Alumni Of The Year, 2002' He is a vital member of the alumni association, especially the West Coast Chapter, to include being a charter member and past President. Joe was critical to the formation of the chapter in '99, and was 'Committee Chair' for the worldwide reunion held in conjunction with the TOD Inactivation Ceremony in April '99. Joe has continued to serve the alumni, both at the local and worldwide level. He can be counted on to support events and never fails to 'lend a hand.'

Joe's selection was announced at the Florida Chapter's annual SnowBall (Feb 8th). He was honored there and will also be recognized at the Command Award Banquet on February 27th and at the '2003 Worldwide Reunion' in late May '03. Joe wasn't at the SnowBall (and cannot be at the banquet), but he will be present to receive his honors at the reunion.

Joe's service to his country began on Sept 1950 and to AFTAC on May 1951, being first assigned to the 1009th Special Weapons Squadron. He retired as a Senior Master Sergeant May 1974 being assigned to the 1155th TOS as Superintendent Seismic Systems Engineering. Joe's AF assignments after his initial training, were within AFTAC. His assignments and duties included: **1009th SWS, 1951-52**, Seismology training, Installed/operated 1 of 50 seismic stations monitoring atomic tests at the Nevada Test Site; **Det 142, 1952-54**, Equipment operations, Met and married wife Gayle; **Det 204, 1955-56**, Operations/maintenance, Son Robert born; **Hqtrs 1035th, 1957-60**, Established/operated first real time recording system for Technical Director, Daughter Carol born; **1155th 1960-61**, Depot Maintenance; **Det 423, 1961-62**, Operation/maintenance, Established new Det from the ground up; **1155th, 1962-66**, Engineering Department, Conducted initial seismic installations on Attu & Murphy Dome AFS, Alaska; **1159th, 1966-67**, Operations Section, Established new Tech Ops Squadron; **1156th, 1967-70**, Operations Section, Performed technical surveys for Det 452; **1155th, 1970-74**, Engineering Superintendent, Directed support for the worldwide seismic system; **Retired May 1974**.
